

Rules for the Competition

- We are offering a prize in exchange for the best zine. The prize is a £50 voucher which can be used in any of the following bars and restaurants: Mono, Stereo, The 78, The Flying Duck and The Old Hairdressers.
- This competition is open to all Glasgow School of Art students. Only GSA students can enter.
- One zine per entrant only.
- So that we can identify your zine, please write your name, current course of study and GSA email address on the interior/blank side of your zine.
- The zines must be submitted in the format shown in the accompanying diagram on the poster and zine template. However, it can be any size, in any medium and on any kind of paper.
- The theme for the competition is START OVER, but we will happily accept zines on any subject if you have something specific that you'd like to explore.
- As zines can be used to convey such a broad range of topics and can come in so many forms it is difficult to set out criteria for what we are looking for without curtailing your creativity. Therefore, we will judge your zines on the basis of the originality of their design and content.
- Once your entry is ready it can be submitted at the Library Information Point.
- The winner will be picked by Harriet Gould (Student President) and Laura Glennie (the previous Student President).
- Once the zines have been judged, the winner will be contacted via email and we will add all entries to the GSA Zine Collection. We reserve the right to withhold zines from the Collection that do not meet our Collection criteria. The deadline for submission is 3/10/18, and the winning entry will be announced on 10/10/18.
- When creating your zine please remember that the Library is a safe space for all library users and that we operate a zero-tolerance policy for any racist, transphobic, homophobic or sexist content.
- Although ordinarily we are happy to purchase zines from students, due to the potentially large volume of zines that may be submitted over the course of the competition we will not be able to purchase any of the entries.
